Imagine Chancellor School Athletics – Parent Code of Conduct

At Imagine Chancellor School, we are committed to providing a positive, safe, and enriching athletic experience for all student-athletes. This Parent Code of Conduct outlines expectations for parent and guardian behavior during all athletic events, including games, practices, and team functions.

By attending and supporting Imagine Chancellor School athletic events, parents and guardians agree to the following:

1. Support Student-Athlete Well-Being

- Place the emotional and physical well-being of all athletes above all else.
- Emphasize skill development, personal growth, and enjoyment over competition or winning.
- Always remember: youth sports exist for the benefit of the students—not the adults.

2. Promote Positive Encouragement

- Be a role model of good sportsmanship, showing respect and kindness to players, coaches, officials, and spectators from all teams.
- Cheer respectfully and positively for Imagine Chancellor teams.
- Avoid negative comments, taunting, or disrespectful behavior toward anyone—including players, coaches, referees, or other parents.

3. Respect Coaches and Officials

- Support the decisions made by coaches and officials, understanding they work to create a fair and positive experience for all athletes.
- Do not confront or question coaches or referees during games or practices.
- Use appropriate communication channels—such as the 24-hour rule—when concerns arise (wait at least 24 hours after an incident before contacting a coach).

4. Avoid Sideline Coaching

- Do not coach your child or others during games or practices unless you are an official member of the coaching staff.
- Let the coaches coach and focus on encouraging the team.

5. Model Responsible Conduct

- Refrain from the use of tobacco, drugs, or alcohol during any athletic event.

- Never attend events under the influence of any substance.
- Avoid aggressive behavior, verbal threats, or the use of profanity.

6. Help Maintain a Safe Environment

- Promote a safe, welcoming atmosphere for all participants and spectators.
- Report inappropriate or concerning behavior to Imagine Chancellor staff or event officials promptly.

7. Respect All Facilities

- Treat both home and away venues with care—clean up after yourself and follow any posted or communicated rules.

8. Know and Follow the Rules

- Familiarize yourself with the sport's rules to be an informed and respectful spectator.
- Adhere to all Imagine Chancellor Athletics policies and procedures.

Consequences for Violations

Failure to follow this Code of Conduct may result in one or more of the following actions, as determined by Imagine Chancellor School administration or athletic staff:

1. **Verbal Warning** – Issued by school or athletic staff.
2. **Written Warning** – Documented notice of a formal infraction.
3. **Event Ejection** – Immediate removal from the event.
4. **Suspension from Future Events** – Temporary ban from attending games or practices.
5. **Full Removal from Athletics Attendance** – Ban from all school athletic activities for the season or permanently, depending on the severity and frequency of the misconduct.
