- ❖ Three middle grades or higher\* courses in English language arts.
- ❖ Three middle grades or higher\* courses in mathematics.
- ❖ Three middle grades or higher\* courses in science.
- ❖ Three middle grades or higher\* courses in social studies.
  - ❖ One of these social studies courses must be Civics.
    - ❖ There is a statewide, standardized end-of-course exam for Civics that must be taken and factored in as 30% of a student's course grade.

**\*May include high school courses for high school credit.**

# WHAT IS CREDIT RECOVERY?

- ❖ Credit recovery, also known as course recovery, allows the student to gain the credit for the course not received.
- ❖ At the end of Quarter 3, Administration will review all middle school students at risk of not receiving course credit due to lack of quality points.
- ❖ Students will be given the opportunity to gain points for a failing quarter during Q1, Q2, or Q3.
- ❖ More information will be provided to parents if it applies.

# CREDIT RECOVERY PROCESS

1. A student fails Q1, Q2, or Q3 for either ELA, Math, Science, and/or Social Studies.
2. During Q4, student is provided an opportunity to show proficiency for the failed quarter.
3. The student must complete the work provided to show proficiency and pass a quarterly credit recovery exam.

If the student passes, credit will be given.

OR

If the student does not pass, credit will not be given.


